Department: Literature in English

Programme:	Creative Writing Workshop
Programme Objectives:	To provide an opportunity for students with talent in writing to expand their creative writing skills by learning from a published writer.
Target students and selection methods:	Targeting students from S4 to S5 who perform above average in English writing. Ideally we would have 12 to 15 students in the workshop.
Schedule and duration of programme:	3 sessions of 1.5 hours occurring once per week each between Lunar New Year and Experiential Learning Week (day of week to be determined by instructor and student availability)
Deliverables:	Engage students who are already writing beyond the requirements of the English curriculum. Encourage students to submit their completed writing for writing competitions such as the HK Young Writers' Association, RTHK Short Story Competition, or the Women in Publishing Secondary School Short Story Competition. Some of these competitions have deadlines in the fall, but the work could be kept submitted when the competition deadline comes up.

Budget	Instructor's Fee – 1500 HKD/workshop. Total = 4,500 HKD

Department: Science

Programme:	Gifted Education in Science
Programme Objectives:	To develop students' potentials and skills in scientific inquiry (e.g. creativity, problem-solving, etc.). It also aims to promote science education, nurture and inspire teenagers who are highly talented in science.
Target students and selection methods:	Around 10 -15 students from S.4; Nominated by teachers based on students' interests and abilities
Schedule and duration of programme:	December 2020 - July 2021, around 12 lessons
Deliverables:	Students attend lectures, working on scientific projects and learning some topics beyond DSE curriculum

Schedule and duration of programme:	2020-2021 throughout the school year
Deliverables:	A number of leadership opportunities will be held to provide leadership training opportunities for students. Student leaders will actively participate in the activities including leadership training camps and student-led activities. After the programmes, students will reflect and evaluate on their learning outcomes and plan on how to apply what they have learnt to their life.
